This checklist can be used to reflect on your classroom practices using Vizzle and by administration to guide observations over the school year.



## Lesson Planning

- Utilizes unit guide to indicate standards-alignment and core content for planning.
- Accesses lesson plans to highlight vocabulary, activities, and leveled learning objectives for instruction.
- Identify ways to ask for support (Help Link, Live Chat, Vizzle Contact).
- Printed lessons or extension activities for offline experiences and UDL best practices.
- Demonstrates rich, rigorous instruction with interactive lesson during group instruction related to weekly topic.
- Circle Academic Focus - ELA - MATH - SCIENCE - SOCIAL STUDIES - OTHER.
- Circle Skills Suite - SOCIAL SKILLS - LIFE SKILLS- TRANSITION/VOCATIONAL SKILLS.

## Student Engagement

- Students have correct level of instruction to support core subjects/student goals.
- All students have access to rigorous content at their independent instructional level.
- Student accounts are customized for interest, age, and accessibility needs.

- Teacher reports student has logged in at home to increase family engagement.

## Instructional Settings

- View report by instructional topic (automatic curriculum tracking card).
